



VACCINE REFRIGERATOR

- Store only vaccine in refrigerator
- Check and log temperature twice a day
- Open the door only when necessary
- Stock vaccine on a first-in is the first-used basis
- Never leave vaccine outside the refrigerator
- Keep vaccine between 2°-8° C
- Don't store vaccine on the door shelves
- Store full bottles of water on empty shelves and in the door
- Stock only a one month supply
