Dogwood Transitional Care Unit (TCU) is a short stay transitional care unit for patients waiting to go to long term care or waiting for community services to be secured.

When you no longer need the level of care of an acute care site, the interprofessional team will determine if your care needs can be temporarily met at Dogwood Transitional Care Unit.

Once Dogwood TCU is determined to be the most appropriate care location for you, the healthcare will complete the referral. The healthcare team will approach you and/or your family to obtain consent prior to finalizing the transfer.

Daily Routines and Activities:

- Activities with Recreation Staff: Art and Craft, Movement and Music, sensory activities, and many more.
